LIGHTING PROJECT

Have you ever sat in a church service where the temperature was way too hot or way too cold? I bet it was hard to concentrate. Or maybe you have sat in a service behind a woman wearing far too much perfume. You couldn't see what was going on through the perfumed fog and your watering eyes. Environment matters when it comes to congregational worship. Distractions abound.

In our sanctuary, we have been limping along for almost 20 years with a woefully inadequate lighting system and the elders have decided to address this problem in 2019. We have accepted a bid for just under \$42k to redo the lighting in the sanctuary, in the fellowship hall, and on the stage. This change will significantly improve the "feel" of our Sunday morning worship and give adequate lighting for us all to read our Bibles more easily.

In our last congregational meeting, there was much discussion around the lighting, what to do, and how to pay for it. There seemed to be the most energy and interest around opening the project up for individuals to donate to if they wish in order to fund part or all the project from designated gifts. In the month of April, those who would like to donate to this upgrade and believe in the project can give directly to it with a designated gift marked "Sanctuary Lighting Project." May God stir the generosity of his people for this needed upgrade because the church exists first and foremost for the worship of King Jesus! Worship is the heartbeat that supplies life to everything else we do as a church.

In our congregational meeting on April 28th, we will evaluate where we are with the funding of the project and together decide next steps. If God would move and more than the necessary funds were received, then gifts above the \$42k will go towards other necessary upgrades in our sanctuary.

'NOT ALONE' MINISTRY

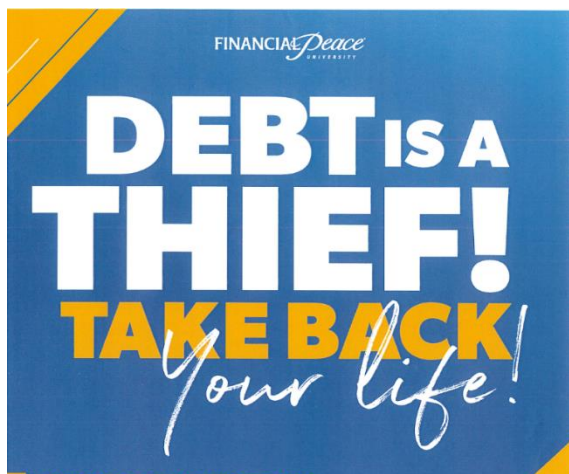
