THANKSERVING PROJECT

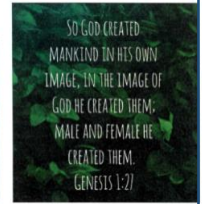
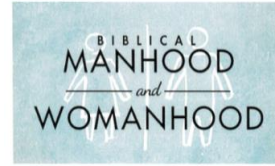

- November 1 Paper Products
 - toilet paper, paper towels, tissues, wipes, diapers, Ziploc baggies, etc.
- November 8 Canned Goods/Snack foods
 - granola bars, soups, vegetables, fruit, pudding, peanut butter, jelly, etc.
- November 15 Laundry & Cleaning
 - laundry or dish soap, disinfectant wipes, cleaning supplies, toilet bowl cleaner, etc.
- November 22 Baking Goods/Pasta and Rice
 - spaghetti, minute rice, macaroni, flour, cake mix, brownie mix, salt, sugar, boxed mixes, etc.
