The price tag reflects our commitment to having the playground be inclusive. We seek to raise \$100,000 to make the dream a reality. We would like to personally challenge each family to consider giving to this project, perhaps as an end of the year family project. We will receive some grants and business gifts, but the majority of the cost will come from right here. Will you consider investing in playground as evangelism?
